<input type="radio"/> Jo Jorgensen and Jeremy "Spike" Cohen Libertarian	<input type="radio"/> _____ write-in, if any	The board of Independent School District No. 14 (Fridley Public Schools) has proposed to renew the school district's existing capital project levy authorization of 5.47% times the net tax capacity of the school district. The money raised by the capital project levy authorization will be used to cover costs related to deferred maintenance and renovation projects at various sites and facilities, technology devices, and technology infrastructure. The proposed capital project levy authorization will raise approximately \$1,016,000 for taxes payable in 2022, the first year it is to be levied, and would be authorized for ten years. The estimated total cost of the projects to be funded over that time period is approximately \$10,160,000. The projects to be funded have received a positive review and comment from the Commissioner of Education. Shall the renewal of the capital project levy authorization proposed by the board of Independent School District No. 14 be approved?
