



# Street Rehabilitation Project No. ST2026-01

Project Update  
March 20, 2026

## Project Status Update:

On Tuesday, March 17, staff advertised the project for public bids. The bid opening for the project is slated for early April with the anticipation of bringing to City Council for award in Mid-April. Construction is anticipated to begin as early as May; however, this is dependent on the awarded contractor's schedule. Once a schedule is confirmed, staff will send a follow-up project update.

## CenterPoint Energy Gas Main Improvements:

Project staff are in coordination with CenterPoint Energy about potential Gas Main improvements within the Melody Manor neighborhood. CenterPoint Energy is working on the extent of the improvements and may begin construction for those improvements as early as April.

## Complimentary Sanitary Sewer Service Inspection:

Reminder that if you haven't already, the City of Fridley offers a free complimentary televising inspection to residents within a street project area of their sanitary sewer service.

The inspection takes 30-60 minutes, and would be scheduled on a weekday between 7:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. A camera is inserted into the line in your home and pushed out to the main. Please ensure the sewer service cleanout in your home is accessible and can be opened prior to your appointment.

If you would like a complimentary camera inspection, please contact the Engineering Division to schedule.

### Fridley Streets For All

We're committed to making streets in Fridley safer and more accessible for everyone—pedestrians, cyclists, motorcyclists, transit users and drivers. The Fridley Streets for All Plan is being developed as a long-term strategy that expands upon recent studies of specific MnDOT and Anoka County-owned roadways to analyze crash trends, identify high-risk areas and recommend countermeasures to reduce crashes and their impacts throughout Fridley's entire transportation network.

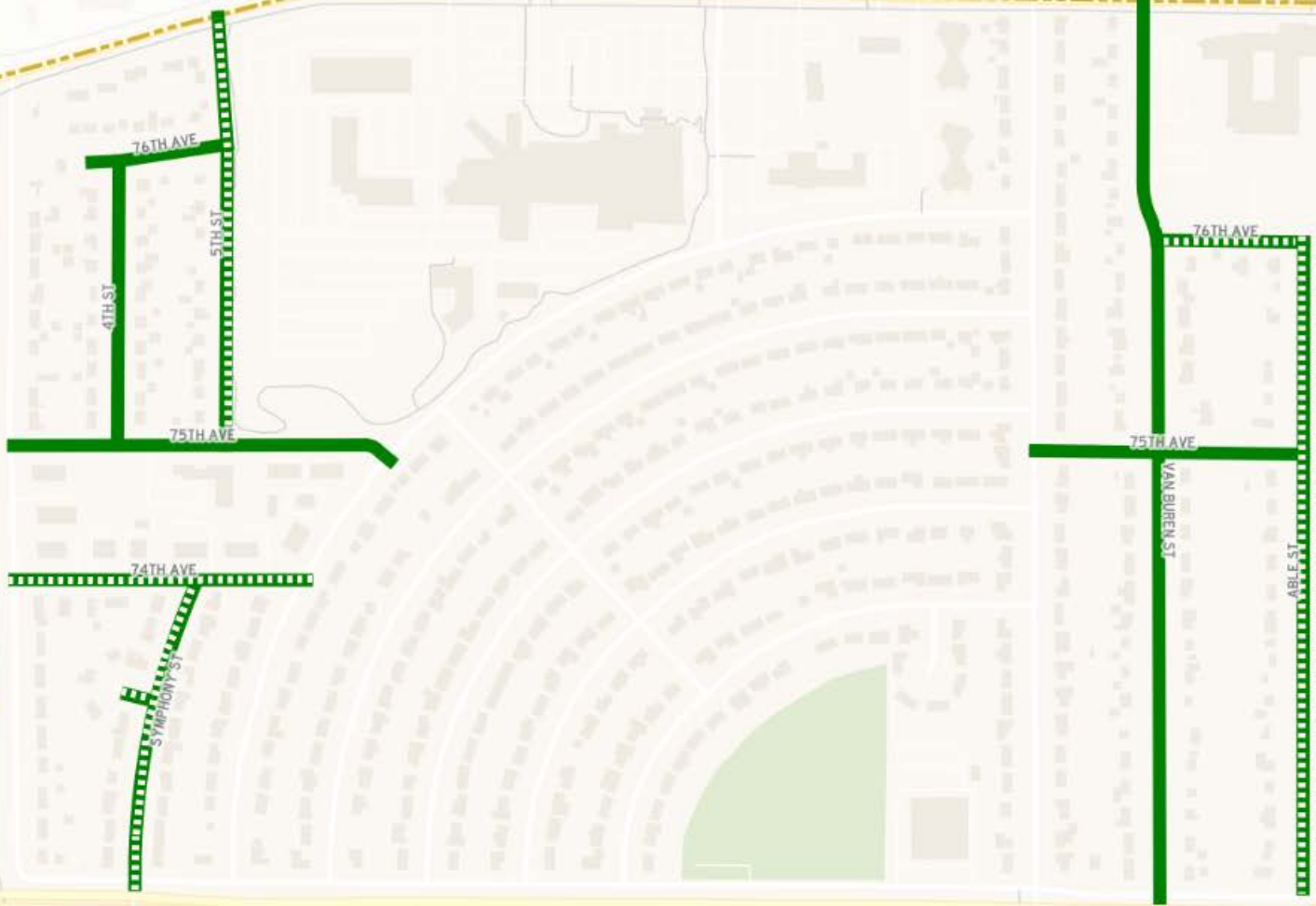
