



Street Rehabilitation Project No. ST2026-01

Project Update
September 11th, 2026

This week, the Contractor completed all concrete curb and driveway installations throughout the project areas. The Contractor also placed the first lift of asphalt along Symphony Street, 74th Avenue, and 75th Avenue west of Lyric Lane, and reinstalled permanent mailboxes for residents along Symphony Street, 74th Avenue, and 5th Street.

Tomorrow, Saturday the 12th, the Contractor plans to place the first lift of asphalt along 5th Street. The Contractor will also place the final lift of asphalt along Able Street, Van Buren Street, 75th Avenue east of Jackson Street, and 76th Avenue east of Van Buren Street.

Next week, the Contractor will begin restoration behind the newly installed curb and gutter, and on streets with asphalt pavement in place, will begin adjusting existing surface utilities within the roadway.

Driveway Access:

Residents on Symphony Street, 74th Avenue, and 75th Avenue will have restored access to their driveways by the end of the day today, Friday, September 11th. Residents on 5th Street will have restored driveway access by the end of the day Saturday, September 12th.

Asphalt Paving:

On streets scheduled for asphalt paving operations, residents must refrain from parking vehicles on the roadway during and immediately following the placement of the new surface. Additionally, drivers are strictly asked to avoid sharp turning and sudden braking on the newly laid asphalt to prevent damaging the fresh pavement.

Street Parking:

On-street parking in areas of active construction will be restricted, unless otherwise noted, during working hours (7:00 am – 7:00 pm, Mon - Fri). Vehicles parked within the immediate work area during certain phases of construction may be subject to towing.

Please note that all construction scheduling is tentative, weather-dependent, and subject to change.

Construction

Once construction begins, the Contractor's hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday-Friday. Occasional work outside of these hours may occur with City approval.

Please keep in mind that this type of construction may generate noise, dust, mud, and be disruptive to the area. Please be patient with the Contractor and contact us with any concerns.

Resident Access

During construction, the City and contractor will work to minimize inconvenience to residents. That said, residents can anticipate occasional impacts to utility services and driveway access during various phases of construction. Generally, impacts to utility services are limited to short durations (hours) while driveway access may be impacted for up to 7 days during concrete work. Properties impacted by construction activity shall receive advanced written notice of such work.
