Construction Schedule Update:

This week, the Contractor completed construction of the new shared-use trail along 61st Avenue from 7th Street to West Moore Lake Drive, including paving, boulevard restoration and signage installation. The portions of the project along the newly constructed trails are now substantially complete. The City and Contractor appreciate the flexibility and patience of project residents and motorists throughout the construction process.

Next week, the Contractor will begin construction of the remaining portions of the project, including 61st Avenue from the University Avenue East Service Road to 7th Street and from Commons Park to Jackson Street. The locations of remaining construction activity are shown in the project map included with this update.

Construction activity next week in these locations will include the installation of traffic control signage, reclamation of the existing pavement and miscellaneous removals in preparation for construction of the new shared-use trails.

Please note that all construction scheduling is tentative, weather-dependent, and subject to change.

The Contractor's hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday-Friday. There is potential for occasional work outside of these hours with City approval.

Please keep in mind that this type of construction may generate noise, dust, mud, and be disruptive to the area. Please be patient with the Contractor and contact us if you have any concerns we can help with.

Resident Access

During construction, the City and contractor will work to minimize inconvenience to residents. That said, residents can anticipate occasional impacts to utility services and driveway access during various phases of construction. Generally, impacts to utility services are limited to short durations (hours) while driveway access may be impacted for up to 7 days during concrete work. Properties impacted by construction activity shall receive advanced written notice of such work.
